

# Cupcake & Potato Week









### What you will need:

- Wool
- Scissors
- Cupcake cases
  - Glue
  - Pom pom



Make your own wool cupcakes

To start with you need to cut a piece of wool about the length of your hand, you need to then put this between your 2 fingers. Then grab the end of your wool ball string and hold that with your thumb you want to start wrapping this around your 4 fingers, you will want to keep going until you have done 10-20 rounds around your fingers. Then snip the end off, the 2 strings your originally put between your 2 finger should be hanging down you are going to use these to a knot around the middle of your layered wool. Once you have done this you should be able to pull the bunch of your hand, you will then need to tie your knot tighter. Then using some scissors, you need to cut the rounded areas of wool so they are separate once you have done this you can fluff it out and this should create your pom pom. The final step is to put your pom pom in your cupcake case and there you have created your own wool cupcake




#### What you will need:


- Potato
