To start with you need to grab some coloured paper if you have any if not you can always use plan paper and colour and decorate it how you like. When you have picked your paper, you will need to draw around both of your hands so you have 2 handprints, Once you have done this you will need to cut it out. Next you will need to create your paper Diya to do this draw your Diya shape on some paper and colour and decorate to how you like. Finally, you need to stick your 2 handprints slightly overlapping so it looks like the will be holding something, then you can stick your paper Diya in the middle of the hands, so it looks like its holding it

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What you will need:

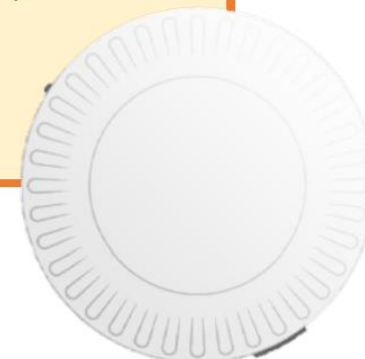
- Paper Plate

Make your own paper plate Diya Decoration



To start with you need to get a paper plate and cut the center out of the plate so you are left with a ring. Next you will need to create the paper Diya's to go around the edge of the paper plate, you can decorate them however you like, you can use different coloured ones to make it more interesting. Once you have drawn enough to go around the edge of the paper plate you can cut them out and begin to stick them on the paper plate. When you have finished this the final thing to do is add some string so you can hang it up wherever you like.



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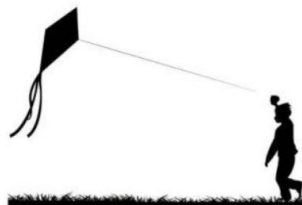

DIY SALT DOUGH DIYA LAMPS



1 CUPFUL OF PLAIN FLOUR (ABOUT 250G)
HALF A CUPFUL OF TABLE SALT (ABOUT 125G)
HALF A CUPFUL OF WATER (ABOUT 125ML)
METHOD.

1. PREHEAT THE OVEN TO ITS LOWEST SETTING AND LINE A BAKING SHEET WITH BAKING PARCHMENT.
2. MIX THE FLOUR AND SALT IN A LARGE BOWL. ADD THE WATER AND STIR UNTIL IT COMES TOGETHER INTO A BALL.
3. TRANSFER THE DOUGH TO A FLOURED WORK SURFACE AND SHAPE INTO YOUR CHOSEN MODEL. YOU CAN ROLL IT OUT AND CUT OUT SHAPES, NUMBERS OR LETTERS USING BISCUIT CUTTERS, OR MAKE ANY KIND OF MODEL YOU CAN THINK OF. WE MADE SOME FRUIT AND VEG SHAPES PLUS CUPCAKES FOR A TEDDY BEAR'S PICNIC.
4. PUT YOUR FINISHED ITEMS ON THE LINED BAKING SHEET AND BAKE FOR 3 HRS OR UNTIL SOLID.
5. LEAVE TO COOL AND THEN PAINT.

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
