The aim of the challenge is to pick up the box only using your mouth and the only thing that can touch the floor is your feet!

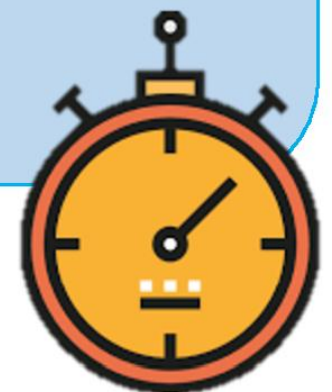
If you find this easy and want more of a challenge you can cut a couple of inches of the top of the box and try again, it will be more difficult as it will be shorter.

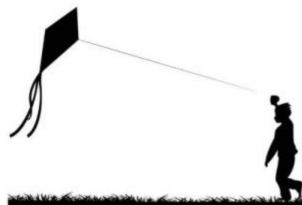

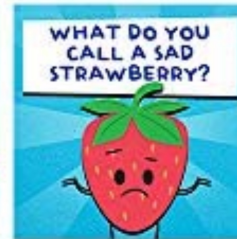

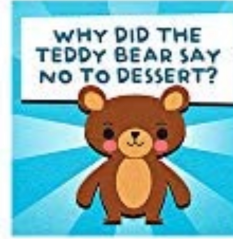
