What you will need:

- Paper plate
- Green and Red Paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Colouring Pens or pencils



Handprint Poppy Wreath

To start with you need to get your paper plate and cut the center out. Once you have done this you can start creating your handprints, to do this on some green paper you will need to trace around your hand. You will need to do this around 5-6 times depending on the size of your paper plate. Then you will need to create the poppies to do this on some red paper draw your poppy shape and repeat this 4 or 5 times. The final step is to stick your handprints around the edge of your paper plate, when you have done this, you can then stick the flowers on top.

- Red Paper
- Green Paint
- Scissors

Toilet Roll Tube Poppy

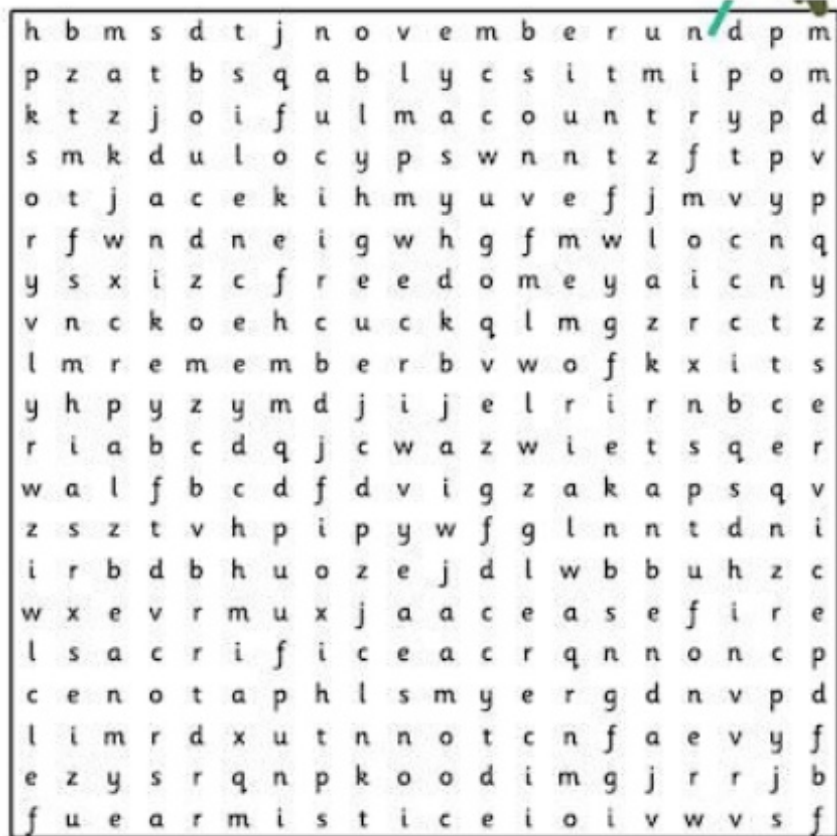
To begin with you need to get your toilet roll tube and paint it green to create the stem of your poppy, put this to the side to let it dry. While you are waiting for it to dry you can make the flower, to do this on some red paper you need to create your poppy shape. Then use some scissors to cut it out and then stick it to the top of your toilet roll tube. For some final touches you can create some leaves using green paper or use plain paper and colour it in. Stick your leaves on and there you have made your own toilet roll tube poppy

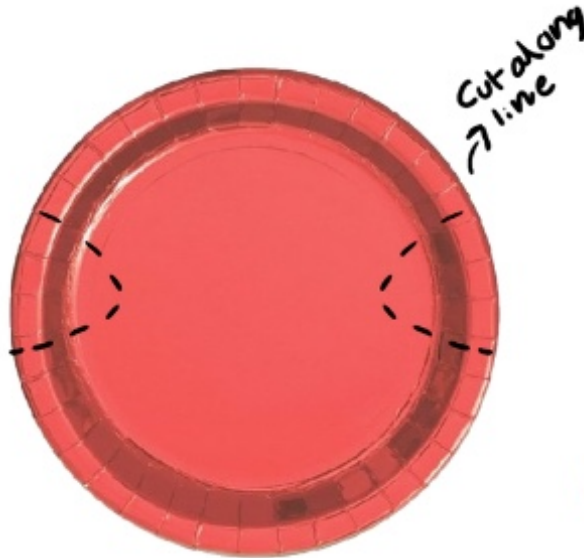
