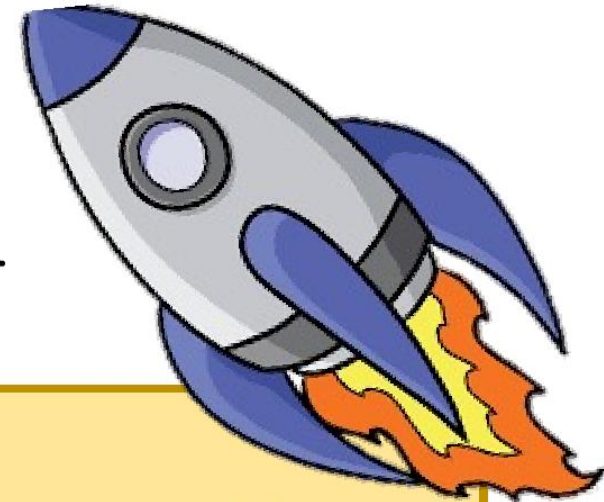

Make your own paper straw rocket

To start making your own paper straw rocket you first need to grab some paper and draw out the shape you want your rocket to be. Once you have done this you can colour it in with whatever colour you like. Next you need to cut out your rocket. Now on the paper you need to cut a small strip of paper which will be able to cover the straw. On the back of the rocket, you are going to use the tape to stick each side of the strip down but not the bottom as this is where you are going to put the straw. Once you have finished you can put your paper straw into the paper area you have just created you can now use the straw to blow through and this should launch your rocket into space!

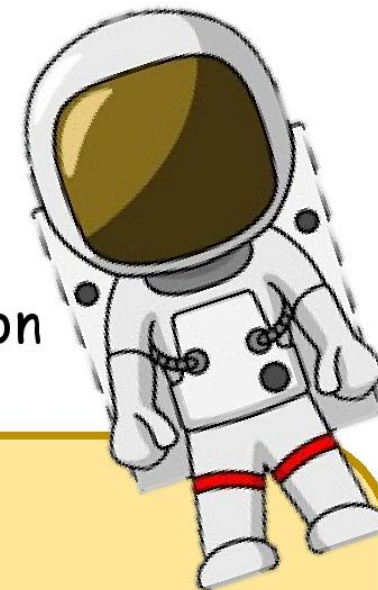

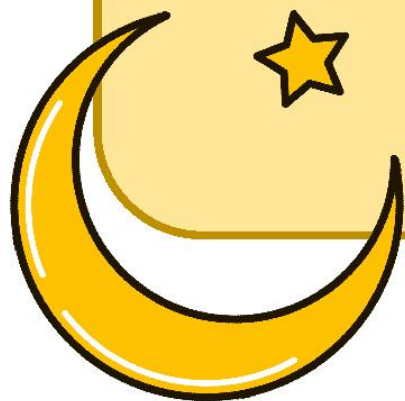
What you will need:
