What you will need:


- Toilet roll tube

Make your own Pudsey pen pot



To start with you need to get your toilet roll tube and wrap it in yellow paper and stick it down. Once you have done this on some plain paper you will need draw some ears for pudsey. You will also need to draw around the bottom of your toilet roll tube to create a base for your pencil pot, when you have cut it out stick it to the bottom of your tube. Next you need to draw your face and stick the ears on your tube. Once you have finished all of this your pencil pot is ready for you to use










What you will need:

CHILDREN IN NEED CUPCAKES



1 cup flour
1/2 cup sugar
1/8 tsp. baking soda
3/4 tsp. baking powder
sprinkle of salt
6 tbsp. butter (melted)
1 egg white
1/4 cup cream cheese
1/4 cup milk
flavoring
yellow icing
m&m's

Instructions:

Bowl 1: Mix together the flour, sugar, baking soda, baking powder and salt.

Bowl 2: Whisk together the melted butter, egg white, cream cheese, milk and flavoring.

Add the wet ingredients to the dry ingredients. Mix until combined.

Divide the batter evenly into cupcake papers.

Bake for 18 minutes at 350.

Now decorate with yellow butter icing and top with mlms
