



Sock Olympics

This winter, if you are stuck inside for the day, try taking part in the sock Olympics and see who can win the most games. To play all three games you need lots of pairs of rolled up socks, a box or basket and a blind fold.

Game 1: Sock Toss-

Stand in a line with the other participants facing your box, you each get three socks and the winner is the person who can throw the most socks in the box.

Game 2: Sock Tag-

Everyone has two separate socks which you have to secure so it is hanging out of your trousers, and you have one hanging on each side of your body. To play the each sock represents a life and you have to steal each others socks without losing yours. The last player with a sock still attached wins.

Game 3: Find the Sock-

Make a pile of all the socks you have. Then one participant is blindfolded and handed a pair of socks. Without removing the blindfold they have to memorise the pair of socks. Then the socks are put back in the pile, blindfold is removed and the participant has to find the pair from the pile.

Who can find the pair with the least guesses.
